Positive risk taking is not about doing things and not thinking about, or ignoring, what could go wrong.



North Somerset Council are committed to supporting you to do the things you want to do. We will work alongside you to plan how to achieve your goals and dreams.



Taking risks can lead to you, or someone else being hurt or harmed.





Risk enablement planning is a way of stopping and thinking about the possible risk of you, or someone else, being hurt or harmed.



We will have a conversation with you about what could be done to reduce the risk and record the decisions we make together.



If the risks are high someone will be asked to keep in contact with you to make sure you, or no-one else, is being harmed.
