


Somerset is slightly worse than regional and national averages with a higher percentage of children having more than 3 placements (15% in 2023 compared to 10% nationally) and a lower percentage being in placement for at least 2 years (68% in 2023 compared to 69% nationally).

Children in Care have worse educational outcomes than their peers across all key stages, this is the case regionally and nationally.



Youth offending (rate per 10,000) The rate of first-time entrants to the youth justice system (aged 0-17) has fallen locally, regionally and nationally over recent years from a rate of 572 per 10,000 in North Somerset in 2014 to 78 in 2022. The reoffending rate has increased in North Somerset in 2021.
