

## Previous consultation

In 2023, North Somerset Council held a consultation into the possible introduction of a Residents' Parking Scheme in Weston-super-Mare.

The consultation helped the Council better understand parking issues impacting the local area and its residents. This engagement produced valuable feedback, which has been considered in further development of the Weston-super-Mare Residents' Parking Scheme.

Consultation feedback	Response
General agreement on streets within the scheme, but some concern around possible knock-on effects to neighbouring streets.	This is a pilot scheme and may help inform future schemes in neighbouring areas helping reduce possible impacts
Proposed hours of operation were supported by those within the Residents' Parking Scheme and less so with those outside of it.	The proposals have been amended to be consistent between the resident parking and pay and display parking
Some concerns were raised by those by those with multiple vehicles.	Residents with driveways may apply to have the double yellow line across their access removed so they may park across their drop kerbs. Permits are available in Locking Road car park for additional vehicles. The scheme will be reviewed after 12 months and the amount of available parking assessed.
Some businesses and organisations had some specific needs that they felt were not met by the current proposal.	Business and customer permits have been accommodated within the resident parking scheme. Business and customer permits are available for Locking Road car park.
Concerns raised by Blue Badge holders.	Blue badge spaces are available within the area. Residents with blue badges may apply for a resident permit.

As set out in the Introducing the Residents' Parking Scheme section, the Weston-super-Mare scheme now requires a further statutory consultation through the TRO process.



Advertisements setting out how to comment on the TRO will be published in the coming weeks. We expect the statutory consultation period to begin in October.
