

## NOTICE OF INTENT

### Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### North Somerset Council, (Speed limit Restrictions, North Somerset)

### Consolidation Order 2024 (Variation No.3) Order 2025

Ref: SLTR/DB/2501

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council propose to make an order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The general effect of the order shall be to amend the North Somerset Council (Speed Limit Restrictions, North Somerset Consolidation Order 2024 to revoke the existing 40mph speed limit on Queens Road, Nailsea, and create a 30 mph Speed Limit on Queens Road instead. The extent of the proposals are described in the Schedule to this Notice.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with the plan and Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the following locations:
