06 Access Officer's Report (oral report)

The Secretary presented a verbal update advising that the section of the coastal path at Ladye Bay remained closed, and that North Somerset Council were in discussion with Natural England concerning the closure. This was due to the coastal erosion which was causing concern for public safety.
