

Big Nath's BBQ

Project name: Big Nath's BBQ 2.0



Big Nath's BBQ were established in Backwell in 2021, initially as a street food trader, catering for private events as well as selling their products wholesale. They have recently opened their own BBQ school and have put down roots with local community organisations. The business has now grown to the point that they do not have enough capacity to meet the demand for their product. As a result, they applied to the Rural England Prosperity Fund (REPF) to help purchase new and larger scale kitchen equipment including a smoker, chiller, fridge, and freezer.

This new equipment will increase their production volume and quality, allowing them to meet their current demand as well as expand their customer base. The new equipment will also result in a range of benefits beyond the business, by increasing the number of local farmers and suppliers they use and quantities of meat and products purchased. The business currently run a monthly takeaway from their headquarters in Backwell. The increased capacity will allow them to enhance their outreach, innovate and scale up.
