Carbonating soft drinks



Bradleys Juice are a rural soft drinks company in Hewish. They used their 2024/25 Rural England Prosperity Fund grant to help purchase an in-line carbonator for their automatic canning line.

Previously, the juices were carbonated using a pressure tank, which took 24 hours to get to the correct carbon levels. The carbonator has enabled the business to set the level of carbon required and mixes it with the product as the cans are filled. This has meant that they can now run the canning line five days a week instead of two, increasing production from 4,000 to 20,000 cans.

The business received a carbon audit in 2023 through the North Somerset Green Grant Programme, and they are now working towards becoming a Zero Carbon company. The new method of carbonation will reduce the carbon used by 50% helping them to get ever closer to their zero-carbon goal.

The business employs local people, uses local suppliers and supports other craft drink producers by canning and packing their products. The investment will not

only improve the sustainability, efficiency and productivity of Bradleys Juices but also support local businesses and supply chain.
