Elephant and Wildlife Safari - Tractor and Trailer Ride



For over 15 years, Noah's Ark Zoo Farm operated a tractor ride, a traditional farm ride. This was popular with visitors with over 15,000 people enjoying the ride each year at its peak. The zoo had to stop operating the tractor ride as part of Covid restrictions and the tractor's trailer fell into disrepair. The zoo received regular feedback from visitors asking them to re-instate a tractor ride.

Noah's Ark Zoo Farm used the Rural England Prosperity Fund (REPF) as an opportunity to re-introduce the tractor ride but in a way that reflects the organisation's new vision as a conservation and education charity with a focus on conservation, education, people, and wellbeing. The tractor ride will have a new route planned which will provide people with a unique experience seeing the 20-acre elephant habitat and experiencing elephants roaming this area and the willow plantation. This will bring the experience of being on safari in Africa to North Somerset and make this accessible to thousands of children, young people and adults each year. The trailer will also provide safe access for taking groups to off-show areas of the site to carry out conservation work and to run

tailored wildlife experiences. The route will also be accessible to wheelchair users and other people who struggle with mobility.
