

Notice of confirmation of an Order

Highways Act 1980

North Somerset District Council

(Part of Restricted Byways LA 7/44 and LA 7/33 and parts of Public Footpaths LA 7/43 and LA 7/33)

Public Path Diversion Order No. 2 2025

On 10th July 2025 North Somerset Council ('NSC') confirmed the above Order, made under section 119, Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert part of Restricted Byways LA 7/44 and LA 7/33 and parts of Public Footpath LA 7/43 and LA 7/33 in the Parish of Dundry, within the District of North Somerset as described below:

Part of Restricted Byway LA 7/44: *from* point A (grid ref. ST 54826 66849) running in a South, South Westerly direction to point B (grid ref. ST 54816 66822), a total distance of approximately 28 metres.

Restricted Byway LA 7/33: *from* point B (grid ref. ST 54816 66822), running in a South, South Westerly direction to point C (grid ref. ST 54787 66773), then running in a South, South Westerly direction to point D (grid ref. ST 54758 66734) a total distance of approximately 109 metres.

To a Restricted Byway from Point A (grid ref. ST 54826 66849), running in an Easterly direction to point E (grid ref. ST 54889 66848), then running in a generally South, South Westerly direction to point F (grid ref. ST 54851 66711), a total distance of approximately 208 metres.

Part of Public Footpath LA 7/43: *from* Point G (grid ref. ST 54794 66818) running in a general Southerly direction to Point C (grid ref. ST 54787 66773), a total distance of approximately 43 metres.

To a footpath from point G (grid ref. ST 54794 66818) running in a general Easterly direction to point H (grid ref. ST 54814 66815), then running in a general Northerly direction to point A (grid ref. ST 54826 66849) a total distance of approximately 56 metres.

Part of Public Footpath LA 7/33: *from* point I (grid ref. ST 54924 66874) running in a South Westerly direction to point B (grid ref. ST 54816 66822), a total distance of approximately 135 metres.

To a footpath from point I (grid ref. ST 54924 66874) running in a South Westerly direction to point E (grid ref. ST 54889 66848), a total distance of approximately 45 metres.

The Order comes into force on the 7th August but, if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 30th July 2025, make an application to the High Court.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 2 2025

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order and the public, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Castle Farm, Dundry and shown by bold continuous lines (points A-B-C-D, points G-C and points I-B) on the Map No. ‘PPO 212’ contained in this order and described in part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highways mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. Notwithstanding this order, National Grid Group and Bristol Water PLC shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1, namely: they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths (points G-H-A and points I-E) and a restricted byway (points A-E-F) over the land situated at Castle Farm, Dundry, described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken and bold dashed lines respectively on the Map No. ‘PPO 212’ contained in this order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

Part of Restricted Byway LA 7/44: *from* point A (grid ref. ST 54826 66849) running in a South, South Westerly direction to point B (grid ref. ST 54816 66822), a total distance of approximately 28 metres.

Restricted Byway LA 7/33: *from* point B (grid ref. ST 54816 66822), running in a South, South Westerly direction to point C (grid ref. ST 54787 66773), then running in a South, South Westerly direction to point D (grid ref. ST 54758 66734) a total distance of approximately 109 metres.

Part of Public Footpath LA 7/43: *from* Point G (grid ref. ST 54794 66818) running in a general Southerly direction to Point C (grid ref. ST 54787 66773), a total distance of approximately 43 metres.

Part of Public Footpath LA 7/33: *from* point I (grid ref. ST 54924 66874) running in a South Westerly direction to point B (grid ref. ST 54816 66822), a total distance of approximately 135 metres.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

To a Restricted Byway from Point A (grid ref. ST 54826 66849), running in an Easterly direction to point E (grid ref. ST 54889 66848), then running in a generally South, South Westerly direction to point F (grid ref. ST 54851 66711), a total distance of approximately 208 metres.

To a footpath from point G (grid ref. ST 54794 66818) running in a general Easterly direction to point H (grid ref. ST 54814 66815), then running in a general Northerly direction to point A (grid ref. ST 54826 66849) a total distance of approximately 56 metres.

To a footpath from point I (grid ref. ST 54924 66874) running in a South Westerly direction to point E (grid ref. ST 54889 66848), a total distance of approximately 45 metres.

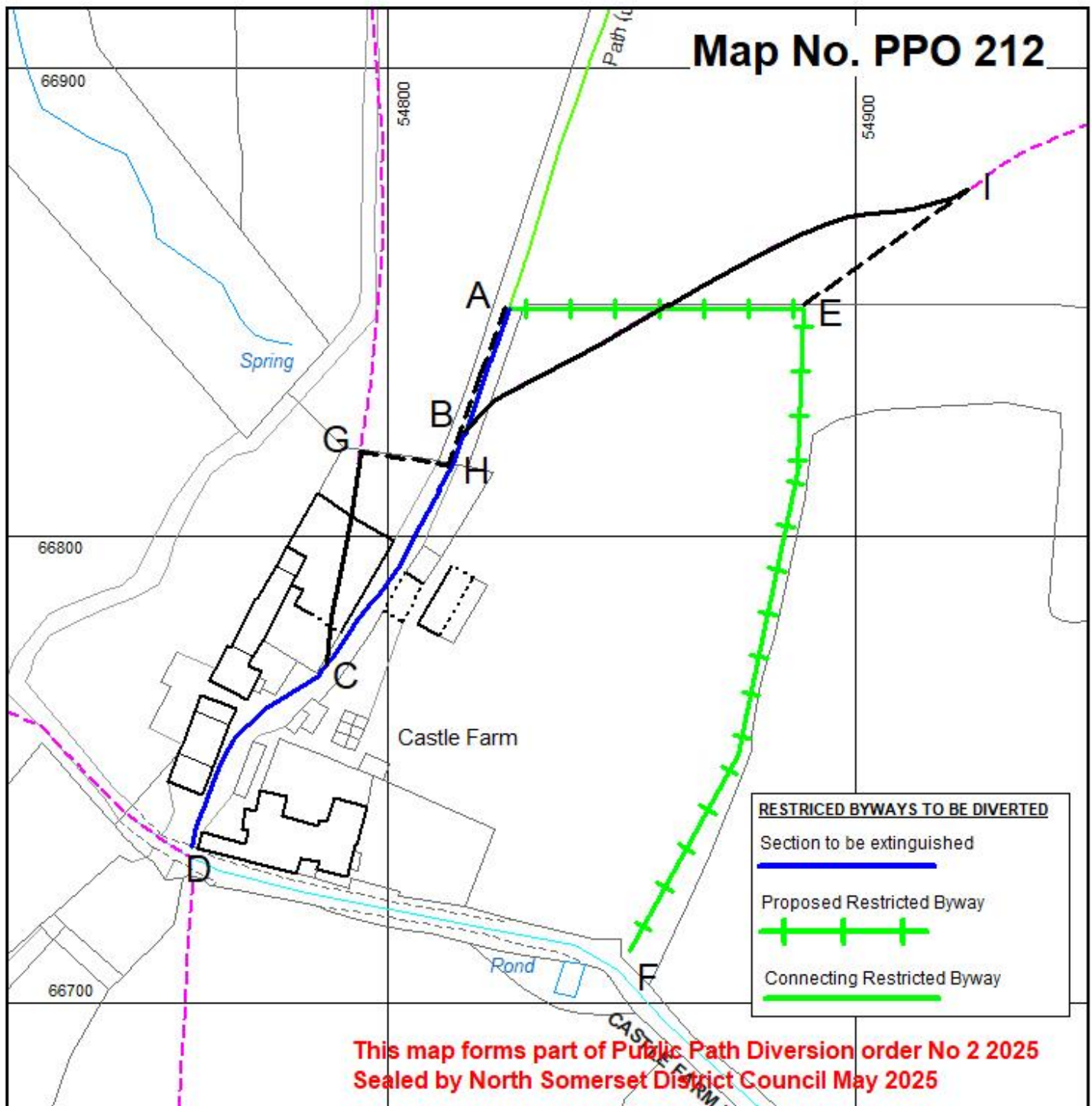
The proposed restricted byway will have a natural pasture surface as currently exists in the field and a width of 4 metres.

The proposed footpaths will have a natural pasture surface as currently exists in the fields and be a width of 2 metres except between points A and H where it will be 2.5 metres as it is enclosed by hedgerow on both sides.

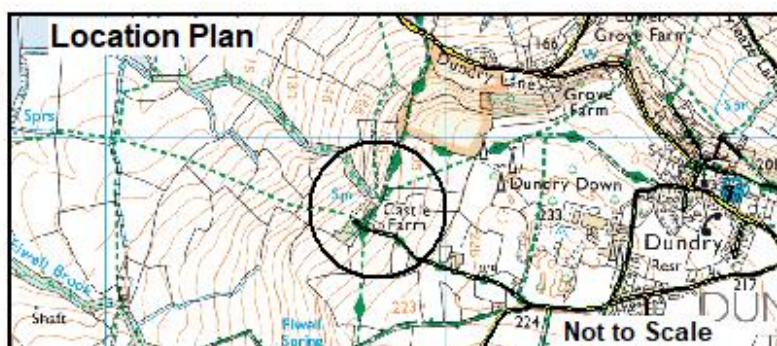
