Nailsea Library

Location and premises

Site address: Unit 6-8 Colliers Walk, Crown Glass Shopping Centre, Nailsea, BS48 1RH

Paid car parking is available in adjacent shopping centre car park.

The library moved from its previous location in Somerset Square in summer 2023 to a new location on Colliers Walk where the former HSBC bank was located. North Somerset Council have taken out a long lease on the site for 125 years. The former three units have been refitted, followed by a bespoke interior design fit out. Extended Access has been installed at the new site to increase access and opening hours.

Among nearby libraries, Clevedon Library is the closest to Nailsea after its own (5.7 miles away).

In terms of public transport links, the town is served by Nailsea & Backwell railway station (approximately a 20–25-minute walk away from the library) and bus routes X8 (to Bristol) and X6/X7 (to Clevedon).

Opening hours:

The library is staffed for 34.5 hours a week. Extended Access is available to registered users for a further 48.25 hours a week during unstaffed hours.

Visits:

In 2024-25, there were a total of 57,172 visits to Nailsea Library. Of these, 54,839 (95.9%) occurred during staffed hours, with a further 2,333 (4.1%) during unstaffed Extended Access hours.

Nailsea Library ranked third out of the 11 council-run libraries in North Somerset in terms of overall visits during 2024-25.

Visits by time of day:

Staff have been recording visitor footfall numbers during the initial half hour of opening and on an hourly basis thereafter since week commencing 27 January 2025. The table below shows the percentage of visits taking place during the monitored period (to week ending 29 June) by time of day (i.e. between 27 January and 29 June, 13.9 percent of the total number of recorded visits at Nailsea Library took place on between 9.30 and 10am).

Services and activities

Nailsea Library is a very busy library in the north of the district and is well used in both staffed and self-service opening hours.

- In 2024-25 the library lent or renewed 98,408 items
- As of 1 June 2025, Nailsea Library has 8,377 registered users
- 343 events were hosted at the library in 2024-25, with a total of 3,241 attendances recorded, (representing instances of participation rather than unique individuals)
- There were 2,556 hours of public computer use and 13,740 printouts in 2024-25

Services offered at the library include:

- Self-service borrowing
- Books, CDs, DVDs, books on CD to borrow
- Thermal image cameras for loan
- Children's library
- Study space
- Computers, printing, wi-fi, photocopying & scanning facilities
- Newspapers (National, 5 x a week, local, 4 x a week)
- Access to subscription databases and eResources
- Extended Access
- Designated warm space; charging for devices, hot drinks, warm, friendly space, access to support and information

Regular activities, supported by partners and volunteers, include:

- Story time and Rhymetime sessions for pre-school children
- Councillor surgeries
- Computer support sessions
- Reading groups
- Craft activities for all ages
- Family history advice sessions
- Family board games sessions
- Scam awareness sessions
- Lego Club
- Code Club

No other services are co-located with the library and there are no separate lettings. The library is available for hire outside of opening hours. Commercial organisations occasionally rent space in the public area for provision of their community/outreach services.

Face-to-face service

North Somerset residents who are unable to access council services online or by phone can receive in-person support and signposting from library staff at Nailsea Library.

For more complex enquiries - such as those related to Housing or Council Tax - where an immediate answer may not be available, staff will direct residents to a dedicated council services phone located within the library, ensuring access to the appropriate specialist support.

Staff and volunteers

Eight members of staff work from the building, on a part time basis. This comprises one Community Services Supervisor (Level 6) and seven Community Services Officers (Level 4)

There are 15 volunteers actively engaged in supporting Nailsea Library throughout the year. These volunteers are involved in digital help, family history support, children's activities, code club and library services volunteering (e.g. helping to shelve returned items). A further 16 volunteers support the library in short-term roles (such as helping with the annual Summer Reading Challenge).
