

# **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

## **NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL**

### **WALFORD AVENUE & BRISTOL ROAD, WESTON-SUPER- MARE, (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND PARKING PLACES)(CONSOLIDATION) Order 2022 (Variation No.20) ORDER 2025**

North Somerset Council proposes to amend parking restrictions on Walford Avenue and Bristol Road, Weston-Super-Mare.

The changes are required to facilitate the installation of a new signalised pedestrian and cycle crossing on Walford Avenue. The controlled area of the new crossing will replace the existing parking restrictions at the Queensway end of Walford Avenue. The existing restrictions on the north-west side of Walford Avenue near its junction with Pastures Avenue will be extended to meet the crossing's controlled area.

The amendments are part of North Somerset Councils approved Bus Service Improvement Plan (BSIP) and are designed to improve road safety at certain areas, to facilitate the passage of traffic particularly buses, prevent danger to road users, to prevent damage to the Highway, and help to improve the amenities of the local areas.
