- old and frail
- have a physical or learning disability
- sensory impaired
- autistic
- experiencing poor mental health.



Our plan ('commissioning strategy') is for 7 years and says how we can support people to be safe and to live happy lives. The plan says what we currently organise ('commission') and how much it costs.



It is important everyone lives in a safe community, and we support people by spending money in a sensible way.



We have our ideas set out about how we will spend money to help people get the support they need ('annual commissioning intentions report').
