BS Resource is tight but road safety team are aware of the signs in use in some other areas.

SL Updated group that traffic light sensors may require you to be in the middle of the lane to trigger green lights.

### 3. **Scheme Delivery Updates**

#### - Duck Lane

Missing link between Pier to Pier route and Yatton Station (Onwards to Strawberry Line), removing the need to join the B3133. Now complete, subject to some remedials and signage amendments.

The project also included signage from Yatton Station through to the link, via Horsecastle.

Next steps: Work to progress traffic free route from Yatton Station to Arnolds Way along the old track bed.

#### - Schools

NSC schools lead has been working with schools to develop travel plans via Modeshift STARS. 6 schools have achieved awards (Priory, Worle Village, Beckett, Crockerne, Windwhistle, St Peters).

### 4. **BSIP Update**

Pause of the Bus Service Improvement Plan programme has now been lifted, following public engagement and a review of schemes. STARS team have been working internally to ensure active travel is considered.
