NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL STATEMENT OF REASONS ROAD HUMP - WILD COUNTRY LANE, LONG ASHTON

The introduction of a road hump on Wild Country Lane, Long Ashton, is intended to create a safer environment for those road users accessing the new Scout Headquarters on Wild Country Lane.

The road hump will assist in:

- avoiding danger to persons or traffic using the road, and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- facilitating the passage on the road, of any class of traffic, (this could include all types of motor vehicles or other road users such as cycles or pedestrians).
- preserving the character of the road in a case where it is especially suitable for use by persons on horseback or on foot.
- preserving or improving air quality.
- reducing vehicle speeds.
