

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Election of a District Councillor for North Somerset Council Clevedon South ward

1. Election

An election is to be held of one district councillor for the above district ward.

2. Nomination papers

Nomination papers may be downloaded from <https://n-somerset.gov.uk/council-democracy/voting-elections/upcoming-scheduled-elections/clevedon-south-ward-election> or obtained at the Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 1UJ from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector, prepare a nomination paper for signature.

Delivery of the nomination papers

Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 1UJ on any working from Friday 2 January 2026 between 10am to 4pm but no later than 4pm on Friday 9 January 2026.

3. Poll

If the election is contested, a poll will take place on Thursday 5 February 2026.

4. Registering to vote

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 20 January 2026. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.

5. Absent votes

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Wednesday 21 January 2026. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>

Applications to appoint a proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by no later than 5 pm on Wednesday 28 January 2026. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5 pm on Thursday 5 February 2026. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 28 January 2026. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 28 January 2026.

6. Voter authority certificate

Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 28 January 2026.
