**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended' and of all other enabling powers, has made an order the effect of which is to temporarily prohibit waiting and loading to all vehicles on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and enforcement of the restrictions.

This order was required because of the need to implement measures for public safety and the facilitation of road works as part of the BSIP (Bus Service Improvement Plan) works being undertaken by North Somerset Council. This order became operative on the **5**<sup>th</sup> **January 2026** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the prohibition of waiting and loading may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works. The prohibition of waiting and loading will be from 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026 for approximately 13 weeks. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when and where the measures are in force.
