Notice is given in accordance with The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 and the 'Making significant changes ('prescribed alterations') to maintained schools - Statutory guidance for proposers and decision makers, October 2018', that Baytree School, 1A Kelting Grove, Clevedon BS21 6YF and Highlands Lane, Weston-super-Mare BS24 7DX intends to make a prescribed alteration from 01 September 2026.

North Somerset Council, working with the Governing Body of Baytree School, proposes to increase the place value of the school (which supports the provision of education for children aged from 3 years to 19 years with profound and complex learning difficulties) from 120 places to 160 places located across both the Weston-super-Mare and Clevedon sites with effect from 1 September 2026.

The school's second site at Kelting Grove in Clevedon, was future proofed in its design to be able to cater for 65-85 children. It is therefore likely that the additional capacity would be mostly at this site, due to these numbers being considered within the design and the planning of the building. As of November 2025, there were 145 children on roll at Baytree School and therefore increasing the place value to 160 represents an increase of 15 pupils.

The proposal will be implemented by North Somerset Council with support from the Governing Body. This Notice is an extract of the complete proposal.
