

# **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

## **NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL** **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23** **PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS CHURCHILL, SANDFORD & WINSOMBE**

North Somerset Council proposes to construct various new pedestrian crossings on several roads, in higher volume pedestrian areas within Churchill, Sandford and Winscombe, in the interest of improving access to the local amenities and pedestrian movements within this locality.

This proposal will help to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road, prevent damage to the road, facilitate the passage of pedestrians, encourage more walking, preserve the character of the roads, and improve access to the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
