

**NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL**  
**CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS**  
**VARIOUS ROADS IN CHURCHILL, SANDFORD & WINSCOMBE**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in exercise of the powers conferred by section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 90C (1) of the Act and those bodies or persons prescribed by the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 (hereinafter called 'the Regulations') and in accordance with section 90C (2) of the Act intends to construct a raised table at the locations specified in the Schedule to this notice.

1. Flat Top Road Hump referred to in Schedule 1 will extend across the whole width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in height, 7.5 metres in length, subject to tolerances in the Regulations.
2. Flat Top Road Hump referred to in Schedule 2 will extend across the whole width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in height and 6.75 metres long, subject to tolerances in the Regulations.
3. Round Top Road Hump referred to in Schedule 3 will extend across the whole width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in height and 5 metres long, subject to tolerances in the Regulations.
4. Flat Top Road Hump referred to in Schedule 4 will extend across the whole width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in height and 5.5 metres long, subject to tolerances in the Regulations.
5. Flat Top Road Hump referred to in Schedule 5 will extend across the whole width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in height and 6.65 metres long, subject to tolerances in the Regulations.
6. Flat Top Road Hump referred to in Schedule 6 will extend across the whole width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in height and 8 metres long, subject to tolerances in the Regulations.
