

# **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

## **NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL** **SECTION 90A OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980** **CONSTRUCTION OF RAISED TABLES**

It is proposed to install traffic calming measures in the form of raised tables across Churchill, Sandford and Winscombe.

Installing new raised road tables is designed to encourage driver behaviour to comply with the 20mph speed limit in some places and reduce intimidation from traffic for vulnerable road users. They will also help to encourage more walking and cycling and improve the amenities of the areas through which the roads run.
