

# North Somerset Council litter picks

## Terms and conditions

Please read this terms and conditions document before you submit your application for a litter pick event.

### Definitions

These terms and conditions only cover ad hoc events, or an event that only occurs once.

This includes events like:

- community/resident litter picks
- corporate days
- events such as Keep Britain Tidy's 'big spring clean'

### Insurance

- Our insurance will only cover residents working on land that we manage, using our risk assessments. It does not cover anyone working on land that is not owned/managed by us. We cannot lend equipment in these circumstances.
- Charities/corporate organisations carrying out work on our land are not covered by our insurance. If you belong to any of these, you will have to produce your own public liability insurance with a minimum value of £5m
  - risk assessments will also be required
  - the event will need to be booked in through the relevant team for that area.
- Events run in association with a friends group, such as litter picking events or wassail, are covered by our insurance only if an event-specific risk assessment is produced. This will have to be provided to the responsible officer and kept on record in our files.

### Health, safety, and risk assessments

- Risk assessments must be adhered to and submitted before an event
- We can only support events on land that is safe to work on
- We cannot support events or lend equipment to proposals that involve work in unsafe areas



- For example, working on roads with speed limits over 30mph with no pavements or grass verge
- Event leaders are responsible for ensuring the risk assessment and safety guidelines have been read and signed by all participants
- All participants under the age of 18 must be supervised by an adult at all times.
